Here's how the system enhances pedestrian safety in low-light conditions ...




Detection in Low Light

Upon detection, Vantage PedSafe triggers overhead lighting, ensuring pedestrians are fully illuminated for approaching drivers.

Driver Alerts Through Dynamic Signage Blank-out signs activate to warn right-turning or oncoming drivers of a pedestrian present in the crosswalk.
